POLISH NUN WHO HELPED SAVE JEWS DURING HOLOCAUST DIES AT 110. Believed to be the "oldest nun in the world," Sister Cecylia Maria Roszak died on Nov. 16, 2018. At the age of 21, she entered a cloistered convent of Dominican sisters in Krakow, at the "On Gródek" monastery. In 1938. she travelled with a group of sisters to Vilnius. Sr. Roszak and her sisters, led by their superior, hid 17 members of the Jewish resistance in their convent, risking their lives to do so. Despite the enormous difference between the two groups, very close relations were formed between the religious Christian nuns and the left-wing secular Jews. In 1984, the nuns were awarded the "Righteous Among the Nations" by Yad Vashem, which recognizes non-Jews who risked their lives, freedom or positions to help Jewish people during the Holocaust.
