

The Holy See's Teaching on Catholic Schools

Essential Marks of Catholic Schools Founded on a Christian Anthropology

Emphasis on the supernatural destiny of students brings with it a profound appreciation of the ned to perfect children in all their dimensions as images of God (cf. Gen. 1:26-27). Catholic theology teaches that grace builds on nature. Because of this complementarity of the natural and the supernatural, Catholic educators should have a sound understanding of the human person that addresses the requirements of both the natural and the supernatural perfection of the children entrusted to their care.

Repeatedly the Holy See's documents emphasize the need for an educational philosophy built on a correct understanding of who the human person is. How do they decide such an anthropological vision?

In Lay Catholics in Schools: Witnesses to Faith, the Vatican propose a response: "In today's pluralistic world, the Catholic educator must consciously inspire his or her activity with the Christian concept of the person, in communion with the Magisterium of the Church. It is a concept which includes a defense of human rights, but also attributes to the human person the dignity of a child of God...It calls for the fullest development of all that is human, because we have been made masters of the world by its Creator. Finally it proposes Christ, Incarnate Son of God and perfect Man, as both model and means, to imitate him is, for all men and women, the inexhaustible source of personal and communal perfection."

All this says nothing more than the words from the Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World, so frequently quoted by Pope John Paul II: "It is only in the mystery of the Word made flesh that the mystery of man truly becomes clear."


