PART THREE: CHRISTIAN PRAYER Section One: Prayer in the Christian Life

CHAPTER ONE THE REVELATION OF PRAYER

PRAYER IN THE AGE OF THE CHURCH

555. When is thanksgiving given to God? 2637-2638; 2648 The Church gives thanks to God unceasingly, above all in celebrating the Eucharist in which Christ allows her to participate in his own thanksgiving to the Father. For the Christian every event becomes a reason for giving thanks.

556. What is the prayer for praise? 2639-2643; 2649 Praise is that form of prayer which recognizes most immediately that God is God. It is a completely disinterested prayer: it sings God's praise for his own sake and gives him glory simply because he is.

CHAPTER TWO THE TRADITION OF PRAYER

557. What is the importance of Tradition in regard to prayer"? 2650-2651

In the Church it is through living Tradition that the Holy Spirit teaches the children of God how to pray. In fact prayer cannot be reduced to the spontaneous outpouring of an interior impulse; rather it implies contemplation, study and a grasp of the spiritual realities one experiences.

558. What are the sources of Christian prayer? 2652-2662 They are: the Word of God which gives us "the surpassing" knowledge" of Christ (Philippians 3:8); the Liturgy of Church that proclaims, makes present and communicates the mystery of salvation; the theological virtues; and everyday situations because in them we can encounter God.
