PART FOUR: CHRISTIAN PRAYER

Section Two: THE LORD'S PRAYER: "OUR FATHER"

580. Why is it called the "Lord's Prayer? 2765-2766; 2775

The *Our Father* is called the "Oratio Dominica", that is, the Lord's Prayer, because it was taught to us by the Lord Jesus himself.

581. What place does the *Our Father* have in the prayer of the Church? 2767-2772; 2776

The Lord's Prayer is the prayer of the Church par excellence. It is "handed on" in Baptism to signify the new birth of the c hildren of God into the divine life. The full meaning of the Our Father is revealed in the Eucharist since its petitions are based on the mystery of salvation already accomplished, petitions that will be fully heard at the coming of the Lord. The Our Father is an integral part of the Liturgy of the Hours.

"OUR FATHER WHO ART IN HEAVEN"

582. Why can we dare to draw near to God in cull confidence? 2777-2778; 2797

Because Jesus, our Redeemer, brings us into the Father's presence and his Spirit makes us his children. We are thus able to pray the *Our Father* with simple and filial trust, with joyful assurance and humble boldness, with the certainty of being loved and heard.

583. How is it possible to address God as "Father" ? 2779-2785;2789 2798-2800

We can invoke the "Father" because the Son of God made man has revealed him to us and because his Spirit makes him known to us. The invocation, Father, lets is enter into his mystery with an ever new sense of wonder and awakens in us the desire to act as his children. When we pray the Lord's Prayer, we are therefore aware of our being sons of the Father in the Son.


