COMPENDIUM OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

PART 1– Faith; Believing Truly Lex credenda The Creed in General

1. What is the Christian meaning of the word *creed*? From the Latin *credo* (I believe), it signifies a brief summary of the Christian doctrine, promulgated by the Church.

2. What are the principal creeds? The Apostles' Creed, the Niceno-Constantinople Creed, The Athanasian Creed, the Tridentine Profession of Faith, and the Credo of the People of God of Pope Paul VI.

3. Which creed is most used? The Apostles' Creed, because it is the briefest and most ancient summary that we have of the doctrine taught by the apostles.

4. Why was the Apostles' Creed composed? 1. To give Christians a clear and simple summary of Jesus's doctrine;2. To guarantee their unity in the same faith.


5. Do the other creeds express the same doctrine as the **Apostles' Creed?** Yes. Some of the articles are developed more fully in the other creeds, to guard against various errors that have arisen from time to time.

6. How many articles are in the Apostles's Creed? There are twelve, as follows:

- 1. I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.
- 2. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord;
- Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary;
- 4. Suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried.
- 5. He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead;
- 6. He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Almighty;
- From thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead;
- 8. I believe in the Holy Spirit;
- 9. The holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints;
- 10. The forgiveness of sins;
- 11. The resurrection of the body;
- 12. And life everlasting.
