Section 1: God the Father and Creation
I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and
Earth

Chapter 3: Creation Fact of Creation

85. Then creation is really distinct from God, and subordinated to Him?

Yes. Throughout history, various false religions and pantheistic philosophies have regarded creation as a diving manifestation, emanation, or somehow part of God (see Rom 1: and Ws 13)- but the true God is in no way dependent on creatures.

86. In our time, what is the chief error about this distinction between God and creation?

The personification and even deification of nature, often manifested in forms of environmental idolatry, ecological mysticism, Earth-goddess rituals, animism, and other forms of pagan worship.

87. What is the error of so-called "transhumanism"?

Man's attempt to negate his creatureliness and elevate himself to a hghr level of existence by manipulating human nature through technology (genetic engineering, cryonics, implants with brain-computer interfaces, etc.), in order to achieve self-perfection or even an alleged immortality. Transhumanism embodies man's original sin of wanting to be like God without grace.

88. Why is a correct understanding of creation so essential to right faith?

Because "error with regard to the nature of creation begets a false knowledge of God."
