THIRD ARTICLE OF THE CREED

Chapter 10: The Life of Christ Doctrine of Jesus

362. How did Jesus Christ demonstrate the perfection of His doctrine?

The moral principles He taught are the most beautiful that can be conceived,, and He illustrated them by the supreme holiness of His life.

363. How was Our Lord regarded as a teacher?

His teaching possess divine authority, and not the mere authority of human learning: "He taught them as one having authority, and not as their scribes" (Mt 7:29). As an example he stood as a perfect and universal model of all virtues. His life, like His doctrine, was without spot or stain. Without fear of contradiction, He could say to His enemies: "Which of you shall convict Me of sin?" (Jn 8:46).

Works of Jesus

364. How did Christ publicly confirm His doctrine?

By miracles and prophecies. A *miracle* is a sensible effect that is produced by God outside the natural order. A *prophecy* is a knowledge of hidden things, particularly the foretelling of future events with a precision impossible to human reason alone.

365. Which of Our Lord's miracles are specifically mentioned in the Gospel?

Several exorcisms, miracles upon the natural world, physical healings, and resurrections. "But there are also many other things that Jesus did; if every one of them were written down, I suppose that the world itself count not contain the books that would be written.

366. What are the prophecies of Our Lord about?

His Person, His disciples, the Jewish people, the history of the Church, and the end times.

367. What prophecies pertain to His Person?

Principally those of His Passion, his death on the Cross, and His Resurrection.
